Role of Nurse Assistant (NURS 110) 5 hours

Role of the Nurse Assistant covers the classroom theory instructional portion (90 of 139 clock hours) of a seven week program designed to prepare students to provide basic health care in hospitals and nursing homes.

Basic Nursing Procedures (NURS 111) 2 hours

Final two weeks of a seven week program designed to prepare students to provide basic health care in hospitals and nursing homes. This course, the clinical portion of the curriculum, is a continuation of NURS 110. Prerequisite: successful completion of NURS 110.

Employment Skills for CNA (NURS 108 and NURS 109) 1 hour

This course is designed to provide practical information to students concerning the career of the Certified Nurse Assistant profession and to determine if this is the career path they wish to take.
