

Citing Electronic Resources: MLA Style

MLA citation no longer requires a web address -- check w/your instructor to determine his/her preference. When in doubt, include one. These examples all include one. Some use short "permanent links" found in the databases. Others use the main database address. Follow the example to see which is a better choice for this particular resource and to identify the appropriate main address for site.
