In response to Randy Fletcher's proposal that DACC request approval for online degrees in other areas of study, Mr. Wyckoff agreed, as well as the other members. It has been suggested that this may impact the timeline for proposal for institutional change to be completed.

Team members have been requested to seek information on similar online AGS degree programs both in and out of state.
