

Heartsaver® eLearning Courses

COURSE PURPOSE:

These courses are designed to teach the basic life support skills of First Aid, CPR for victims of all ages, use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) for adults and children and choking relief. Participants will receive a course completion card valid for 2 years from the American Heart Association. These are hybrid courses (Part 1 is online & Parts 2-3 are completed with an AHA Instructor at DACC). Choose one of the options shown under HEARTSAVER COURSES & FEES below.

HEARTSAVER COURSES & FEES:

- **CPR AED Only:** \$23.00 (online module fee to AHA) + \$40.00 (skills session fee to DACC) per student
 - CPR and AED Use, Choking Care (Adult victims is the default module with optional Child & Infant modules)
- **First Aid Only:** \$28.00 (online module fee to AHA) + \$40.00 (skills session fee to DACC) per student
 - First Aid Basics, Medical Emergencies, Injury Emergencies, Environmental Emergencies, Choking Care
- **First Aid CPR AED:** \$39.95 (online module fee to AHA) + \$40.00 (skills session fee to DACC) per student
- **Pediatric First Aid CPR AED:** \$29.99 (online module fee to AHA) + \$40.00 (skills session fee to DACC) per student; designed by the AHA for child care employees (Child & Infant victims are the default modules with optional Adult module)

REGISTRATION STEPS:

FOR eLearning (HYBRID) HEARTSAVER COURSES:

1. Visit www.onlineaha.org to register/pay for and complete Online Part 1.
 - a. Register as a New User.
 - b. Select Course Catalog then Purchase the Heartsaver Course from those available (Online Part 1).
 - c. Enter payment information payable by credit/debit card. Fees vary by the module chosen.
2. Print your certificate of completion.
3. To Schedule Parts 2 & 3, Skills Practice and Testing, call (217) 443-8777 or email cce@dacc.edu. This will establish the exact date and time for your Skills Practice and Testing with an Instructor on the DACC campus.

*Parts 2 & 3 are usually available T, W, Th from 4:00-5:00 p.m. Ask if these times do not work for you.

 - b. Click on Register Online link below green boxes
 - c. Click on Register for Corporate & Community Education Classes and enter "CPR" in the Search for (key word) box on the following screen.
 - d. Select a CORP-050 course during month you wish to schedule your skills session from the available choices (i.e. CORP-050-JAN if you will schedule your session in January) and continue to the payment/registration screens. Check the box next to the CORP-050 course you want and click Submit.
Fee: \$40.00 payable online with VISA/Mastercard/Discover. (Duration: 1-hour)
 - e. Bring the certificate of completion from Part 1 to your scheduled skills session at DACC.

No book purchase is required. You will receive your AHA provider card after you complete Parts 2 & 3 (skills practice and testing). This card is valid for 2 years. Please note: This class is a non-credit class and does not serve as a replacement for HLTH 102.
