Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 3.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale) – subject to change based on the applicant pool. The transfer GPA range for Fall 2018 accepted applicants was 3.6 to 4.0.
2. 30-75 transferable credit hours completed or in progress by term of application.
3. The following courses **must** be completed before entering the College of Commerce and Business Administration at the University of Illinois:
 - CACC 101 Financial Accounting
 - CACC 105 Managerial Accounting
 - CECN 102 Micro-Economics
 - CECN 103 Macro-Economics
 - ENGL 101 Rhetoric and Composition I
 - ENGL 102 Rhetoric and Composition II
 - INFO 135 Concepts in Programming
 - MATH 125
 - MATH 135 or 137
4. The Online Application is strongly encouraged. Your application will be processed more quickly and you will be able to check its status online. Online Applications can be accessed at www.oar.uiuc.edu/prospective/ugrad/apply.html.

Notes:

1. See a DACC advisor for a list of the IAI general education core.
2. A foreign language requirement in Commerce applies to transfer students first enrolling at UIUC Summer 2002 or later. For graduation, students must complete at least 4 years of the same foreign language in high school or 4 semesters in college. Students are encouraged to complete this language requirement prior to transfer to allow for reasonable course loads junior and senior years. Effective Summer 2002, completion of the 3rd-year level of high school foreign language or the 2nd-semester level of college foreign language will be required of transfer students for admission to the college.
3. Remember that only the 4th level of foreign language counts as DACC/UI humanities credit. Therefore, if the foreign language requirement was completed in high school, a humanities elective must be completed in this slot.
4. Business **Administration/Management** majors are **required** to take PSYC100, Intro to Psychology, as this social science elective. PSYC240, Social Psychology, is also required of Business Administration majors.
5. The Financial Accounting and Managerial Accounting sequence must be completed on the same campus. Students may not take CACC 101 at DACC and then take CACC 105 at U of I or another campus.
