Transfer Admission Requirements:

- 1. 2.0 Grade Point Average (4.0 scale).
- 2. A grade of C or better is required in MATH 111 (or ACT math score of 26 or higher).
- 3. Completion of PSYC 100 with a grade of C or better, as well as all other PSYC courses counting toward the major.

Notes:

- 1. At EIU, all students must have completed a foreign language in either high school or college. This requirement may be met by completing two years of a single foreign language in high school with a C or better, or two semesters of a single foreign language in college.

 Psychology electives include: PSYC 120, 201, 205, or 260.
- 2. Students should take MATH 111 unless they received an ACT Math Score of 26 or higher. An additional math elective is required for DACC. MATH 161 is recommended, especially if students plan to obtain post graduate degrees later.
