Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).

Notes:

1. ISU requires the third level of a college foreign language for a BA in Political Science. Students who want ISU's B.S. degree in Political Science can fulfill the foreign language requirement with three years of one foreign language in high school or completion of the second semester or higher of college-level foreign language with grades of C or better or equivalent proficiency as determined by exam. American Sign Language may be used to fulfill this requirement by transfer credit or by proficiency.
2. ISU suggests a literature class as the way to satisfy this requirement.
3. POLI 160 and POLI 240 will satisfy ISU's AMALI requirement.
4. DACC recommends a three-hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. It is required for teacher certification majors.
5. Suggested Electives: CECN 102 and CECN 103. You must complete and pass CECN 102 with a C or better to take CECN 103. POLI 130, POLI 170, POLI 231, POLI 238, or POLI 270
6. Only needed if credit hour have not reached the 60 credit minimum.
7. Student pursuing a B.S. should take an additional math, statistics, or computer science course beyond the required general education.
