Transfer Admission Requirements:

1. 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale).
2. Students should keep a portfolio of their work in all studio art classes.

Notes:

1. DACC recommends a three (3) hour course in Third World or Non-Western Culture, either in Humanities or Social Science. A Third World or Non-Western Culture course is required for teacher certification. See your counselor for a list of these courses.
2. Students pursuing a BFA may substitute an elective.
3. Due to additional courses for art majors, a bachelor's degree will generally take 3 years to complete after transferring to SIU (5 total years).
4. Art Education, Ceramics, Communication Design, Industrial Design, and Metalsmithing students are recommended to take ARTS 115.
5. The School of Art and Design offers two undergraduate degrees, the Bachelor of Fine Art & the Bachelor of Arts (BA). The BFA, a professional degree, includes ten specializations: Art Education, Ceramics, Communication Design, Drawing, Glass, Industrial Design, Metalsmithing, Painting, Printmaking, Sculpture, Photography, and Art Therapy.
